FIRE CHIEF REPORT

Chief Fletcher reporting:

- MVA billing Trustees are looking at a proposal to initiate billing for Motor Vehicle Accidents, hazardous spills and structure fire if there is criminal intent.
- ➤ Lodi/Harrisville Twp. EMS Proposal
- ➤ EMS grant acquired by Assistant Chief Williams last year will be submitted for reimbursement of \$5,900.
- Promotional Applications for the Captain positions approved last year will be posted June 24, 2011.
- Runs to date is 35
- Ron and Pat will each check with their legal counsel on the SOG's.
- Chief provided mental/physical health support to members this month due to a couple of incidents. Pat commended the chief for this support given to his volunteers.
