Special Meeting August 17th, 2020

Trustee Horner commenced the meeting via Zoom on August 17th, 2020 at 6:32 pm. Roll call: Patterson-here, Schmidt- here, Horner- here. Meeting commenced.

Chief's Report

- -Chief Fletcher in attendance.
- The damaged drip edge under the red siding is being replaced. The damage was caused by sun/heat.
- -FEMA Grant for \$2,352.00 was received. It can be used for PPE purchases related to COVID-19.
- -No update on the pavilion. The Fire Association is scheduled to meet later this evening, August 17th, and they should be discussing the pavilion. Details to ensue.
- -CARES Act- Chief Fletcher is asking if Westfield Township would consider sub-granting their remaining funds to assist the WFRD in purchasing self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBAs). Ours are currently 18 years old and the average cost of a new SCBA is \$5,500.00. The village of Westfield Center has reached out to WFRD and asked if they could use some of the village's remaining funds for any COVID-19 related purchases. The Ohio Township Association has resources available for us to research if the purchase falls under the CARES grant, however, we need to make final appropriations prior to October 15th according to FO Kurtz. Chief will reach out to the state to see if Westfield Township is able to sub-grant the remaining CARES Act funds to WFRD.
- -No action was taken by the Chief based on the discussion during last meeting's executive session. Chief is working on the plan of action discussed previously.
- -Trustee Schmidt asked Chief Fletcher to look into a comprehensive 5 or 10-year plan to lay out what major equipment purchases will need made. Schmidt recommends organizing a task force to assist in compiling the list of purchases and planning on possible levy placement on the ballot in the upcoming 1 to 2 years. Trustee Horner suggests that we wait until residents see the new fire station before considering placing a levy on the ballot as well as having the WFRD officers sit on the task force. Chief stated that the repairs on the 1999 pumper tender fire truck are running approximately \$5,000-6,000 per year. This truck will need to be the next one to be replaced. Also,

one of the WFRD EMS squads is in need of replacement. These two purchases would be approximately \$500,000 in total. In addition, new turn-out gear will need to be purchased soon and the gear runs approximately \$3,000.00 per person.

-Lexipol update- Chief reached out to local fire departments to see if they are currently using this application. Most of the departments are utilizing Lexipol for their policy and procedure needs. OTARMA will financially assist in the purchase of Lexipol.
