Old Business

- The Pavilion should be completed by the end of this month, according to contractor Tim Minnow.
 Work will start this week. The concrete will be poured after the pavilion is erected.
- Chief will approach the Fire Association to ask for their consideration to provide the funding for a
 wall that needs to be erected in the mezzanine at the new fire station.
- Lieutenant opportunity- external panel interview occurred and has been scored. The Chief is hopeful to promote the top candidate lieutenant during a swearing-in ceremony on 10/19/20.
 Chief would also like to budget for an additional lieutenant next year.
- Amended certificate was received from the county Auditor's office. The received funds can now be appropriated. Moving forward, FO Kurtz suggests that when the board of trustees approve to spend funds(grant money), consideration should be towards purchasing the needed item and then donating it to the WFRD rather than donating the funds directly to the WFRD.

New Business

- Five (5)- year Business Plan- Trustee Horner reached out to Heidi, the OTA executive director, on how to best approach putting together a planning committee of potential future needs for the WFRD. Chief Fletcher and the officers will work towards compiling the list of necessary purchases that will need to occur in the next 5-10 years. Once complete, the list will be reviewed by the board of Trustees and the planning committee.
- SCBA Update- The MSA representative put together a quote for the purchase of fourteen (14) SCBA's and adapters. The total is \$104,050.98 including the adapters. MSA can pre-invoice if necessary. Although there is a market for the old gear, Chief suggested that we donate it to the local career center to be used for training.
- Boy Scout Project update- The Fire Association is donating \$250.00 toward the scout's \$1,017.05 total cost for the project. Trustee Horner would like more information. Chief will ask him for an invoice.
- Trunk or Treat- Village council member Val Koneck suggested that this would be a good alternative to trick-or-treating. Chief would like to hold the Trunk or Treat in the WFRD parking lot on Halloween. Trustee Schmidt suggests that Chief reach out to Montville Township for some details in the planning of this event.
