Chairman, Jeff Plumer, called the meeting to order by asking those in attendance to stand and Pledge Allegiance to the flag.

### FIRE REPORT:

Jack reported the air pacs have been put out for bid. There are only 2 companies that are licensed in the State of Ohio and he sent those companies the bid specs. The bid opening will be January 31, 2007. A grant has been applied for tornado sirens.

#### **CLERK'S REPORT:**

RESOLUTION 2007-01 A RESOLUTION SETTING TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS FOR YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2007

Tim made a motion to adopt Resolution 2007-01, seconded by Jeff. Roll call: Jeff, aye; Carolyn, aye; Tim, aye.

RESOLUTION 2007-02 A RESOLUTION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ADVANCE OF THE FIRST HALF OF REAL ESTATE TAX COLLECTIONS FROM THE MEDINA COUNTY AUDITOR

Tim made a motion to adopt Resolution 2007-02, seconded by Carolyn. Roll call: Jeff, aye; Carolyn, aye; Tim, aye.

### **ZONING:**

Russ Zupanic asked the trustees to approve funding for a professional planner to help the zoning commission with future planning in the interchange area (Lake Rd. North) (Greenwich Road East to Hulbert). Mark Majewski with Northstar Planning submitted a proposal of \$5,500. Jeff felt the township needs assurance from the zoning commission and Mark of what will

occur and a set time frame. The past experience has been to prolong such planning way beyond the township's goal to have a change in place. Carolyn requested a resident survey be conducted.

<u>Tim Kratzer speaking as a landowner</u>: I have 125 acres that I am interested in developing into a commercial development. The present zoning (local commercial) does not allow what I am interested in developing. I am not asking for Highway Commercial but possibly a different commercial district.

<u>Carolyn</u> - I do not want to re-write the zoning for Kratzer's proposal on Greenwich Rd. Zoning amendments should be resident driven, not proposed applicant driven.

Russ - We want to do what is best for the community.

Jim - Possibly if there is a new district it may give more options.

<u>Carolyn</u> - I offered to apply for a comprehensive plan grant from the county but at that time the board was not interested. I would like to wait for a county grant cycle to offset the cost.

<u>Jeff:</u> The grant would take too long and only a portion of the cost would be recouped. This study needs to be started and not wait for a grant. Is the commission looking at both Lake Rd and Greenwich Rd?

<u>Jim:</u> We already have language for Lake Rd. But it has not been acted on because the commission said hold off until something wants to come in.

<u>Jeff:</u> Before the board approves funding, Marlene was asked to get a price for just an initial consultation. She will have it by Wednesday, January 17<sup>th</sup>, 2007.

Carolyn suggested the issue be tabled until January 17th, 2007.

#### **ROADS:**

Carolyn met with Fred Boreman January 8th, 2007 and she was given guidelines on Force Accounts and wants to adhere to those guidelines. She related that the county is to do all the paper work.

Tim stated that the road and culvert projects will take an a very long time to get anything done because the county is overloaded with work. Carolyn stated that Force Account is required by the county.

Carolyn reported that she and Tim signed the mileage document at the Engineer's Office. Jeff stated he also signed it after Tim and Carolyn was there.

Jeff asked Lee about the road salt that was delivered. Lee stated he did not want to get too low. Both bins now have salt.

Lee reported that the front wheel seal on the new truck had to be replaced. A bolt from the factory did not have a lock nut on and it worked itself out into the seal. Also a mechanic from Gledhill was on site today to fix a leak in the hydraulic system.

Carolyn related that the manager of the E-Bay business in Seville could sell the old truck. Lee is not ready to let the truck be sold.

#### PARKS & CEMETERY:

Tim reported that Davey Tree gave a proposal for tree pruning at the cemetery. George Tree Service can also do the work.

There was a burial Jan. 12th, 2007 at Friendsville Cemetery.

4 cemetery lots were sold this week.

Waite Funeral Home commended the township on the improved parking area at the cemetery. Tim had a report that the cigarette butt containers at the park are down. Lee will see to the task of setting them upright tomorrow. Carolyn suggested putting sand in the bottom.

### ZONING INSPECTOR REPORT:

Gary reported not too much activity. He has measured signs from Greenwich to Speedco. Most of the signs are not in compliance. The old truck wash sign is grandfathered. The for sale sign at the old truck stop is too large. Jim Likely related that in November 06 the language for real estate signs Bill Thorne did not think it was doable.

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

Jeff discussed the counter on the Web Site

Jeff has talked with Mr. Bernardo representing Northeast Ohio Fence & Decking. Mr. Bernardo has agreed to match the specs with Styx Valley for the amount of \$1,550.

Styx Valley's price: \$2,300 Medina County Fence: \$2,264

Carolyn made a motion to award Northeast Ohio Fence & Decking in the amount of \$1,550 to enclose the fuel tank area, seconded by Jeff. Roll call: Tim, aye; Carolyn, aye; Jeff, aye.

Tim mentioned in the past the trustees passed a resolution giving Lee Evans the authority to create the paper work and work out the estimates for the Force Account. It has saved the township time to get projects completed as the county is overloaded with paper work. Carolyn was not in favor of this because she wants to go by the guidelines. Carolyn asked Martha to give her a copy of the resolution to review. This issue was tabled until a later date.
