Regular Meeting April 1, 2013

Chairman, Trustee Harris opened the meeting by asking those in attendance to Pledge Allegiance to the Flag followed by roll call.

GUESTS WELCOMED

CEMETERY & PARK

Trustee Oiler reporting:

- Lee and I have been in contact with the low bidder for the sidewalk project in the park, secured references and bidder has given written statement that they will begin April 15, 2013, weather permitting. Trustee Oiler made a recommendation to award Premier Concrete & Excavating the bid for the sidewalk project in the park in the amount of \$19,870 beginning April 15, 2013 weather permitting, seconded by Trustee Harris.
- Discussion: Trustee Likley:
 - 1. Possible communication with the village as to the schedule and if they are interested in helping with the cost.
 - 2. Trustee Oiler: This is a capital improvement to our property and the township should pay for the capital improvements but could accept a donation.
 - 3. Trustee Likley wanted the village given the opportunity to share in the cost.
 - 4. Lee: If the township bills them for capital improvement then they could possibly lay claim to a portion of the property, maintenance is maintenance. They cannot lay claim on that property if the township pays for the capital improvements.

Roll call: Oiler, aye; Likley, aye; Harris, aye.

Mowing bid for the complex and cemetery

Trustee Oiler stated we have all paper work from Creative Touch and they were the low bidder. **Trustee** Oiler made a motion to award mowing bid for complex and cemetery to Creative Touch for year 2013, seconded by Trustee Harris. Roll call: Likley, aye; Harris, aye; Oiler, aye.

ROADS

- Lee had given Lytle's estimate to each trustee.
- ➤ Repairs to Ryan (from Eastlake to Kennard), Buffham (from Westfield to Friendsville), and Kennard Road (west from Friendsville to township line) are estimated repairs that need to get done before we chip & seal in the amount of \$17,542.40. We need to get these repairs done as soon as we can because of the deterioration of roadway.
- By April 15th we should have a bid package for chip & sealing and the asphalt overlay.
- > Daniels Road from Greenwich to interstate bridge will get the asphalt overlay.

Trustee Oiler made a motion to permit road supervisor to schedule the repairs to Ryan, Buffham, and Kennard Roads in the amount of \$17,542.40, seconded by Trustee Likley. Roll call: Likley, aye; Harris, aye; Oiler, aye

Force Account for the Westfield Landing project is \$33,841.23. There is 273 feet that needs to be re-based and re-constructed. The road had been on a non-maintained status for many years and has deteriorated due to the volume of traffic going to the boat ramp now. The section of roadway will need to be excavated 16 inches deep to provide the base and material needed to provide a sound roadway. It will be necessary to close the road for 3 days. It will not be necessary to close the road when Lytle comes in to top coat the area. Lee asked the trustees for a resolution to close the road April 8-10, 2013 weather permitting and if an alternate date is necessary due to weather, the road superintendent will select the alternate date. Trustee Oiler made a motion to approve the Westfield Landing force account project in the amount of \$33,841.23, seconded by Trustee Harris. Roll call: Oiler, aye; Harris, aye; Likley, aye
