Old Business

Solid Waste Management Plan Ratification/Resolution- Sanitary Engineers-Current debt is \$656,842.49 and due by June 1, 2022. Plan- Waste Transfer and some class 4 waste accepted. Likley makes a recommendation to accept the plan since improvements can be made and there was feedback from the community and participating entities. Likley states that more recycling with this plan then with the dirty Merfs' trash collecting of the past.

Thombs makes a motion to accept the Resolution of the Medina County Solid Waste Management Plan through Sanitary Resolution 2015-06; seconded by Likley. Discussion: Schmidt does not agree that this is the proper way to go. Schmidt thinks curbside is a more effective way to recycle trash. Likley added that MC 18 section was added for this exact reasoning. Changes may be made along the way. Also, if a resolution is not passed today then the plan goes back to the EPA for recommendations in 3 years. Thombs stated that there is enough blame to go around but the current group is working hard with local control of the recycling plan.

Early Warning Siren contract is being reviewed by Mr. Thorne. Poles for the siren packages should be in by June. Mr. Thorne is also working on the easement language for the school property. Likley will send to school board upon completion.
